

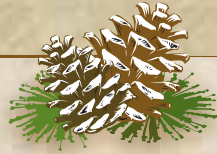

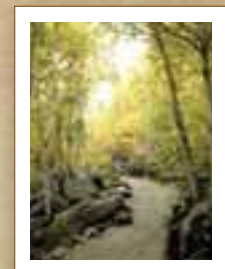

Lodging Reservations

Lodge Rooms

It's easy to make a reservation for a lodge room anytime of year. Our hotel-style rooms include breakfast for two and you'll be within walking distance of most activities.

Cabins

Level 1: Donor First Priority

The YMCA of the Rockies is a nonprofit organization, and all of our wonderful cabins have been generously donated by families who are committed to helping us fulfill our Mission. These donors pay the same nightly rate as all our guests, but they receive first priority when making their reservation requests.

Level 2: Membership Second Priority

A YMCA of the Rockies annual membership entitles you to receive second priority when placing a reservation request.

Level 3: General Public

Because of our unique reservation priority system, we ask that when making your reservation request you provide three or more sets of dates. This flexibility provides us with the best opportunity to fill your request.

Cabins at Estes Park Center and Snow Mountain Ranch may fill to capacity during the summer with priority members. If this occurs, you may still be able to experience the Y of the Rockies by planning to visit us in early June or late August, or by reserving one of our many lodge rooms.

Additionally, if you are a member at any YMCA nationwide, you receive \$10 off per night, per room.

Estes Park Center

This year-round center is located 65 miles northwest of Denver and is surrounded on three sides by the magnificent Rocky Mountain National Park. Our per-night rates vary depending on the type of lodging you prefer. Linens and towels are provided for all guests.

Our lodges are within walking distance of most activities and a stay in a lodge room includes a complimentary breakfast for two. You may also enjoy a variety of meal choices at the Pine Room restaurant, the Rustic Café coffee shop or the Aspen Room, a buffet-style dining room.

Tucked among 860 acres of ponderosa pines, our cabins are fully furnished and include kitchens with eating and cooking utensils, pots, pans, and coffee makers. Snow Mountain Ranch

Located between Winter Park Ski Resort and the town of Grand Lake, this year-round center is 80 miles west of Denver. Our per-night rates vary depending on the type of lodging you prefer.

Stay in a lodge room and a complimentary breakfast for two is included. You may also enjoy eating at The Buckboard Grill, Skinny Ski Café and our buffet-style dining room. Spread throughout 5,000 acres, our cabins are fully furnished and include kitchens with eating and cooking utensils, pots, pans, and coffee makers. Linens and towels are provided for lodge and cabin guests. Tent and RV camping sites are also available during the summer at Snow Mountain Ranch, with electricity hookups, water and sewers.

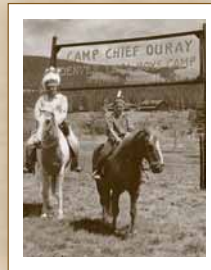


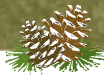
